LOS ANGELES COUNTY ENCOURAGES RESIDENTS AND BUSINESSES TO TAKE AT LEAST ONE DISASTER PREPAREDNESS ACTION STEP DURING ITS 2016 SPRING PREPAREATHON!

Los Angeles County has experienced a few small earthquakes this week that serve as a reminder that it is important to take time to plan what to do in an emergency before it happens.

For the second consecutive year, the Los Angeles County Office of Emergency Management (OEM) and the Los Angeles County Operational Area including County departments, cities, unincorporated area communities, private corporations and media have teamed up with Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) to host emergency preparedness expos, fairs, seminars, and trainings throughout the County as part of the 2016 Spring Los Angeles County's PrepareAthon! (PA) campaign.

"The Los Angeles County's PrepareAthon! is a grass roots campaign that encourages residents and business to take at least one disaster preparedness action step," said Los Angeles County Office of Emergency Management Director Jeff L. Reeb. "There are four key steps to being disaster ready – have a plan, keep supplies, stay informed and get involved. More specific examples include signing-up for Alert LA County, which is an emergency notification system, downloading weather apps to your mobile devices, and packing a "go bag" to evacuate your home or workplace quickly." More specific information is available in the County's Emergency Survival Guide, a free publication that can be downloaded in 13 languages at espfocus.org or ordered by dialing 2-1-1.

Los Angeles County OEM will be coordinating, co-hosting and participating in 14 PA events and activities scheduled from April through June.
