WHO WAS BEHIND THE JANUARY 6TH INSURRECTION AT THE U.S. CAPITOL?



The world watched in horror on January 6, 2021 as thousands of protesters stormed the U.S. Capitol. The mob attempted to overturn President Trump's defeat in the 2020 election by Joe Biden. Five people died and more than 140 were injured. More than 400 persons have been charged with federal crimes and dozens of those arrested were found to be members of white nationalist groups, including the Oath Keepers and Proud Boys.
